The Region Counterdrug Director (DOC) is responsible to Civil Air Patrol (the Corporation) and the Middle East Region Commander to assist and advise the commander in managing and directing the overall counterdrug program for the region. They work in a position of oversight and liaison between NHQ/DO, the NOC, and the individual wing counterdrug officers within the region in developing and implementing their own counterdrug program. This position reports to the MER/A3 (DO).

Qualifications: Officers who meet the following minimum qualifications are invited to apply.

- Must be a member in good standing
- Must be a member of MER, or one of the wings within MER.
- Should already be a CD cleared individual
- Be in the CAP grade of Lt Col\*
- Hold a master rating in one of the operations career fields in CAP\*
- Served as a Wing CD officer \*
- Hold an ICS rating as an AOBD or higher\*

*\* members who have previous current industry qualifications or have unique professional experience may waive these qualifications.*

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assure that each wing participating in the CD program have an adequate number of trained and cleared personnel to fulfill the region's requirements.
- Assure that each wing participating in the CD program schedules sufficient training annually to train and upgrade the authorized CD personnel in their duties and responsibilities.
- Assist each wing in the development of plans and standard operating procedures that support the CD program.
- Serve as the CD advisor to the region commander and region operations staff.
- The Counterdrug Director should be familiar with CAP directives in the 60 series.
